ONTARIO GAMES SPORT TECHNICAL PACKAGE

Technical packages are a critical part of the Ontario Games. They guide the selection of athletes by prescribing the age and eligibility requirements, assist the organizing committees by detailing tournament formats and scoring procedures, help with all aspects of Games planning including transportation budget, meals, accommodations, etc. by describing the number of participants permitted.

Every participating PSO Games coach and/or manager has an obligation to read and understand every aspect of the Technical Package. Failure to do so could cost an athlete his or her eligibility for the Games or could affect final standings or the conduct of the competition. If someone does not understand an aspect of a Technical Package, he or she is to seek clarification from the Provincial Sport Organization or the Sport Alliance of Ontario.

If an individual wishes to initiate change to a Sport Technical Package, the request should be directed to the Provincial Sport Association. Sport Technical Packages are reviewed and negotiated with the Sport Alliance of Ontario and the hosting Games Organizing Committee approximately 12 - 14 months from the games. Change will not be accepted after the Technical Package has been approved for the games without consent of all three parties.

We require two rooms for athletes to warm up. Each room will house approximately 15 athletes and a few coaches. Hotel meeting rooms should be sufficient for space. The rooms should be close to the actual competition hall so the athletes can warm up and be able to quickly move the competition hall. Athletes use these rooms to get changes and warm up for their bouts.

Equipment required to be obtained by the GOC	Regulations Boxing Ring – 5 meters square with a underpadding of 1 inch. This is the same regulation for the amateur boxing ring.
Scoring Tables (dimensions, number)	3 tables – each table will be right beside the ring. The tables should be at least 1 meter long. With 2 chairs beside each table
Officials Tables (dimensions, number)	1 table on the final side of the ring. This table should be 3 meters long with 6 chairs on it.

Please advise of the risk factors associated with your sport (will assist Volunteer Medical Team)	There is a higher risk component as this is a combat sport. However the requirement of a medical doctor and EMT staff is sufficient.
Minimum Standard for Medical Requirements:	We require a Ontario certified MD on site for all competition brackets and for the pre bout medical and post bout medical. In addition we require a EMT Team for this period of time. EMT's can be advance first aiders (St. John's team), paramedics, RNs or RNAs, athletic therapists, etc. We require a minimum of 2 persons for each competition bracket.
